

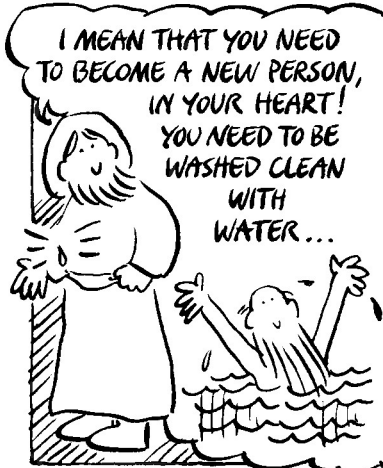
THE SUNDAY PAPER Year A 2nd SUNDAY in LENT
