

Jesus brought us God's Kingdom by sharing our life and our death, and by sharing with us the new life that God gave him. Before he died for us, Jesus showed what God's Kingdom is like. When he healed sick people and forgave people who had done wrong, he showed that God's Kingdom is full of life and hope and love. And he told us that God's Kingdom starts in people's hearts when they begin to live as God's children.

This Sunday we begin reading some of the things that Jesus said about God's Kingdom.
